5th Annual School Fair Returns

On January 22, at the Franciscan Center, on the Lourdes University campus, families were able to explore the different school options at a fair hosted by the Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund and School Choice Ohio.

Representatives from 30 different K-8 learning options were on hand to share information with families and to answer questions. Over 250 attendees learned about traditional public, public charter and private schools, and homeschooling organizations, as well as Ohio's five state-funded scholarships, the Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund, and the EdChoice Scholarship Program.



The School Choice School Fair is planned to coincide with the celebration of National School Choice Week (Jan. 22-28, 2023), which features tens of thousands of school choice celebrations across all 50 states.

The Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund is committed to offering educational choices to low-income families through privately funded scholarships and School Choice Ohio works to ensure that families across the state know about the different educational options available for their children. This is why the collaboration of NOSF and School Choice Ohio makes sense for this type of event.
